Information for Parents / Carers

Fletcher's Fund was founded in memory of a little boy, Fletcher Fisher, who fought cancer bravely for 14 months from the age of 9 months. He loved to have fun and was always smiling, and so his parents and friends decided to set up the charity to spread some of his love and make other people in similar situations smile too.

Our mission is to support children living with cancer by making grants of money in order to enable children living with cancer and their families to make memories.

These grants are designed to allow you to spend quality time with your child and their siblings. If your child is well enough, and you have your consultant's permission, this may well be in the form of a day out to a tourist attraction, or even a special event such as a photography shoot. They could also be used as spending money for a holiday if you would prefer. If not then your grant is to be used to buy play equipment, toys, arts and craft equipment or sensory equipment. All we ask is that you have fun spending your grant and make precious memories together as a family.

Grants are available for any child or young person receiving cancer (or similar) treatment in England, Scotland or Wales up to 6 months post treatment. We require your application to be supported by your Macmillan Nurse, CLIC Sargeant worker or someone else involved in your child's medical care (nurse, doctor, community nurse). This is to verify that your child is eligible for a grant as per the following eligibility criteria:

- Child / young person under the age of 18 years
- Receiving treatment for cancer or related condition within England, Scotland or Wales
- Is currently on treatment or is a maximum of 6 months post treatment

We will contact you should your grant application be successful to ask for feedback on how the grant was used. This will be used for testimonial purposes if you give permission; but is also useful for us to monitor how the grants are being used to ensure that we are providing the best possible service.

Our usual grant is £100, but we reserve the right to alter this amount due to our budgetary constraints, or due to mitigating circumstances of the applicants.
